A short readiness check to support calm planning before you travel

- Feeding routines, litter box care, medication, or supplements need to stay consistent during your absence.
  
- Your cat is sensitive to environmental changes such as new places, unfamiliar animals, or travel.
  
- Your cat may hide, stop eating, or become stressed if their routine is disrupted.
  
- You would like updates or visit summaries without needing to check in while you're traveling.
  
- There should be a clear plan if travel is delayed, extended, or changes unexpectedly.

If several of these reflect your situation, in-home pet care can remove uncertainty while you travel.
